NMFS also assists the fishing industry through marketing service and economic analysis programs, and mortgage insurance and vessel construction subsidies. It collects, analyzes, and publishes statistics on various phases of the industry.

The NOAA Technical Report NMFS Circular series continues a series that has been in existence since 1941. The Circulars are technical publications of general interest intended to aid conservation and management. Publications that review in considerable detail and at a high technical level certain broad areas of research appear in this series. Technical papers originating in economics studies and from management investigations appear in the Circular series.



## ABSTRACT

## INTRODUCTION

This index describes the publications of the Bureau of Commercial Fisheries, U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, issued from 1965 to October 1970, and those of the National Marine Fisheries Service, National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, issued from October 1970 through 1974.

In October 1970, the Bureau of Commercial Fisheries was transferred from the Department of Interior to the Department of Commerce and renamed the National Marine Fisheries Service.

The index comprises a list of each publication series in numerical order and alphabetical indexes of authors and subjects.

This index does not include Commercial Fisheries Abstracts (renamed Marine Fisheries Abstracts in 1973) and Sport Fishery Abstracts. These publications have their own indexing systems.
