Values for components of the prey-specific index of relative importance (PSIRI) used to examine the diets of black sea bass (*Centropristis striata*) caught at natural (left panel) and artificial (right panel) reef habitats through rod-and-reel angling in 2018 off the coast of Maryland. Prey items include annelid, arthropod, fish, and mollusk taxa. The PSIRI is based on the following components: percent number (%PN), weight (%PW), and frequency of occurrence (%FO).
