























CHART 2 - LANDINGS for SELECTED FISHERIES










CHART 3 - COLD-STORAGE HOLDINGS and FREEZINGS of FISHERY PRODUCTS *







CHART 5 - FISH MEAL and OIL PRODUCTION - U.S and ALASKA














CHART 7 - U.S. FISHERY PRODUCTS IMPORTS
