





CHART 2 - LANDINGS for SELECTED FISHERIES





CHART 3 - COLD-STORAGE HOLDINGS and FREEZINGS of FISHERY PRODUCTS *













CHART 6 - CANNED PACKS of SELECTED FISHERY PRODUCTS






CHART 7 - U.S. FISHERY PRODUCTS IMPORTS
