



Supplementary Figure 2. Detections of acoustic transmitters attached to all 81 blacktip sharks (*Carcharhinus limbatus*) that were caught and tagged off South Carolina and Florida in 2017 and 2018. Detections were recorded from May 2017 through December 2019 off the eastern coast of the United States as far north as the Hudson Shelf in New York. Asterisks next to shark ID numbers indicate the 15 sharks determined to have died by using data from tags. The ID numbers for sharks caught from shore appear in bold, and the ID numbers for sharks caught from charter boats are not in bold. None of the tags deployed on the 15 sharks determined to have died were detected on an acoustic receiver more than 10 days after release.
